



WHY PVC VINYL?

PVC vinyl has been used as liner material for above ground and in ground swimming pools since the early 1950's. Today PVC vinyl is the number one product used as a pool liner material. Home owners are doing concrete conversions and putting vinyl liners over the existing concrete finish pools. PVC vinyl has less maintenance and is less costly to maintain than concrete pools.

PVC Vinyl Pool liners have been known to have a 25 year warranty. That's while being subject to chlorine, harsh chemicals, and the abuse received from children and adults.

PVC Vinyl Fish Grade Pond liners are not exposed to chlorine or harsh chemicals, because they would kill all fish and plants. In addition, ponds do not receive the heavy traffic that occurs in swimming pools. As long as the portion of the PVC vinyl liner that remains above the water line is protected from the sun's ultraviolet rays (as would be the lip of a pool liner) – a PVC vinyl pond liner will hold up like its counterpart, (the pool liner). As most people would cover this portion of the pond liner with earth and rocks, to give it a natural look, this should never be a problem.

PVC Fish Grade vinyl liners are safe for fish and plants. PVC vinyl is easy to work with and easily repaired or patched, using spare pieces of vinyl and vinyl adhesive.
